SAMPLE ITINERARY

6/20 DAY 1 – DEPART THE US WITH YOUR TEAMMATES TO BARCELONA, SPAIN – Meet your teammates and coaches at our US departure airport (Bay Area) and fly to Barcelona

6/21 DAY 2 – ARRIVAL IN BARCELONA – CALELLA AND FIRST PRACTICE - Your personal chaperon will meet you at the Barcelona Airport. Transfer to Calella, a quaint Beach town outside of the city and check into your hotel. Have your first practice session getting to know your teammates and coaches. Walk the streets of Calella taking in the beach. Transfer to Mataro and participate in the “Salting Activity”, a staple of Costa Brava. At night dine in the hometown restaurant owned by NBA Star Ricky Rubio.

6/22 DAY 3 – EXPLORE BARCELONA – FRIENDLY MATCH - Shuttle to Barcelona and explore the city for the day. Mont-Juic - The Parc de Montjuïc occupies a vast swathe of the imposing hill overlooking the port, offering a plethora of green areas and gardens, museums and cultural attractions, sports facilities and Olympic sites. Magic fountains & Plaça Espanya - First you visit Plaça Espanya with its marking “dos torres” before walking to the magic fountains of Montjuic and marvel at them when sun set already has taken. These fountains offer a fantastic light show at night. City Center Tour - Includes the world famous Ramblas, the gothic area and Sagrada Familia, the outstanding and never finished church of Antoni Gaudi. Stroll down the Ramblas and admire all the artists, get known to the history of



Barcelona. At night have a second practice and a friendly match against some European competition to get you ready for the Tournament.

6/23 DAY 4 – TOURNAMENT FIRST DAY – Play your first matches of the International Tournament. Enjoy free time at the beach and in Callela as the schedule permits.

6/24 DAY 5 – TOURNAMENT SECOND DAY – Play more matches in the International Tournament. Enjoy free time at the beach and in Callela as the schedule permits.
